Dear Parents and Guardians:

The Bolton Public Schools have contracted with the insurance company, Securranty, to provide families with the option to obtain full coverage for their school-issued Chromebook for a fee of \$28.95. This optional, one-time fee will protect the device for this 23-24 school year only, but multi-year policies are available. Since your child may be moving the device between school and home, insurance is an added layer of protection against accidental damage.

According to Bolton’s Computer System Expectations Policy, parents, guardians, or students may be assessed compensatory charges for intentional acts of damage. The insurance will cover accidental damage, theft, and typical perils such as a cracked screen or broken keys. Now that insurance is available, we will officially assign a device to your child at the start of the school year, and this will be the only Chromebook your child uses both in school and at home. Our IT support will assess the identified issue from there and ensure that your child has a fully functioning device until repairs are completed.
