Dear Parents and Staff,

The state mask mandate in schools will continue until February 28, 2022. As a result, tonight's Special Board of Education Meeting is canceled.

Further, the new legislation preserves the state's authority to reinstate the statewide mask mandate in schools between February 28 and June 30, 2022 if health metrics warrant such a change. Please note at this time under federal order, students will still be required to wear masks on the school bus to and from school and on a school sponsored event. The Board will discuss and determine whether or not to continue the mask mandate beyond the state mandate in the Bolton Public Schools at a Special Meeting via Zoom at 7:30 PM on Thursday, February 24, 2022. The Board and I value public comment and members of the public and the school community are encouraged to attend the meeting.
