## **End of Year Schedule**

Last night the Bolton Board of Education voted to end school for students on the 180<sup>th</sup> day of school which is Monday, June 15, 2020.

As the year begins to wind down, our administrators and teachers have begun the work necessary to wrap up the 2019-2020 school year as well as to plan for the possibility of returning to school in the fall and/or continuing distance learning for a period of time next year. To provide time for this work and to offer opportunities for students to complete or re-do work, we will be holding half-day sessions for students from June 1 – June 15. Beginning June 1st, certified staff will be

available to work with students for three hours per day. For the other three hours, all certified staff will be:

- Supporting students needing review/remediation/to catch-up on work
- Assessing student learning and sharing individual student information with the next year's teachers.
- Documenting content that was not addressed this year and communicating this information to next year's teachers.
- Examining and evaluating both distance learning systems and structures in terms of what worked well, what did not work well, and how to make it better for all our students should we need to have to employ distance learning again next year.
- Developing plans for our return to school.

- BCS 6-8 and BHS teacher/student interaction time will be from 12:00 p.m. 3:00 p.m.
